



COMPLIMENTS TO THE READER

COMPLIMENTS TO THE READER

On behalf of the "Sunshine" Child-Saving Fund – Matthew 18, 14 – I welcome all the readers holding this booklet.

When publishing this booklet we are just taking the first steps towards the aims of our foundation –saving children– though for more than 5 years we have been thinking of ways to find families for abandoned children as soon as possible. Families waiting for them with love, doing their best in order that after a happy childhood and prosperous adolescence they may become useful citizens of this country, keeping away from prisons for juveniles, being able to resist narcotics and the temptation of alcohol and other drugs and harmful ideas, instead choosing to lead a moral life.

If a mother is by no means willing to bring up her child we consider the best solution to be allowing the adopting parents to take the newborn baby home from the hospital as if he or she was their own. We are happy that we have been able to place *several infants in the best possible circumstances in this way.*

One of the aims of our foundation was to establish a Sanctuary for children whose parents renounce them, but *would rather entrust them to the care of the Sanctuary instead of placing them in state controlled children's homes.* In addition, children who, because of their circumstances, should be put to children's homes by the authorities, could also be placed temporarily in this Sanctuary. To avoid this, *our Sanctuary is open for any other solution.* We would like to help the families in trouble with returning their children placed in the Sanctuary temporarily at the earliest possible time. Should it be impossible, we look for adoptants for the children.

We have reached this goal, because the local government of Szigetszentmiklós and the Ministry of Public Welfare support our goals, we reached an agreement with them on 30th september 1991 which granted us a building from 1st november 1991, which we can set up according to our intention and where –in compliance with the official regulations– we can run a refugetype children's sanctuary.

The reconstruction of the building began on 1st november. The Local Government Office as well as private persons gave us a helping hand. The Sanctuary was opened at Christmas in 1990.

Our second object has been achieved, too. Using the designated donations we set up a computerized office with all the necessary technological devices. In this way administration is much faster.

Next, we aim to establish a children's and mother's home, where women in need can find refuge for some months before and after delivery. We would like to open this home in summer, 1992 at the latest.

Our foundation is ecumenical, it is based on the cooperation among the Hungarian Historical Churches.

Our supporters are Roman Catholic foundations as well as Baptist organizations. We are known in almost every country of Western Europe, among which we have the closest connection with England, the Netherlands and Germany. The closest co-operation overseas is with the USA and Canada. We are in contact with the Maltese Charity Service as well as with e.g. the Salvation Army.

We would be pleased, if you, Dear Reader turned over the pages of this booklet in which we try to summarize what we have done and what we plan to do in the near and distant future.

We make no secret of aiming to find new friends. Friends and supporters! If you would like to help us with ideas, work, money or prayer, please, contact us. You will find our address and phone number in different sections of this booklet.

We also ask you to inform your friends and acquaintances about us!

Jesus says in the text of our foundation, the gospel according to Matthew 18th section 14th verse: *God, your heavenly Father does not want a single child to be lost.* We want and work so that God's will may prevail and there would not be any child lost, mentally or physically disabled, growing up in this country without love, or without having a pleasant childhood.

We are well aware that a single foundation is not enough to achieve these objectives. But we are glad to have discovered that several foundations were established with similar aims in this country. We are sure that the union of benevolent people will entail God's blessing and our work will not be in vain.

SOME FACTS

1. Registration of the foundation:

6th november 1990, Budapest, Pest County Court
10.A.83/1990

Citation from the judicial decision: "The aim of the foundation is to establish a Sanctuary for new-borns and infants, to manage fast adoption, to promote the solution of the matter of abortion by Christian means."

2. The head of the competent department in the Ministry of Public Welfare states in his letter No. 46.532/90/XIV: "The Ministry of Public Welfare welcomes the initiative of the Sunshine Sanctuary..."

We also favour their efforts to promote open adoption. This way they undertake an activity which can considerably speed-up the process of placing children in adopting families. We expect their active participation in developing the network of foster-parents. We could succeed in finding foster-parents, preparing them for their tasks, assessing their suitability with the prospective help of the Sanctuary."

3. Residence of the foundation:

SZIGETSZENTMIKLÓS

4. Representative of the foundation: Dr. Mihály Almási 2310 Szigetszentmiklós, Révstor 24. (Letters: Kinizsi u. 3.)

5. The foundation is charitable and absolutely of public interest. We are entitled by the competent office of the Hungarian Tax and Financial Controlling Institute to give a certificate to the bestowers, on basis of which they can deduct the amount of their donation from their tax basis.

Permission No. 135.243-0/01/1992

6. The foundation is open, each Hungarian or foreign individual or corporate body can join by a deposit to one of our bank accounts, or as stated in the 6th article of the constitution (by contributions, collecting, invitation for donation, bequeathing and in other legal ways).

7. We received the first donation, 10,000 HUF, from the Contur Építőipari Szolgáltató Kisszövetkezet.

8. *The first notice on a waif reached us on 15th january 1990.* It seemed unbelievable even for us, that this baby was adopted at the age of 5 days.

9. Our partner foundation in England: Matthew 19,14 "let the little children come to me." advised un in the director's letter of 1st february 1991 that they would do their best to support our foundation. The chairman of the English foundation is Michael Natham M. P. (senator), its treasurer is P. Montacute the Financial Director of the Baptist World League (Washington D.C.).

10. The first considerable donation was sent to us by the Juliana Welzijn Fonds with the assistance of the Stichting Katholieke Noden from the Netherlands. The letter granting 100,000 Dutch Florines was dated on 19th july 1991.

11. Our first leaflet was published in january 1991.

12. The second leaflet was published in three languages and was distributed in 30,000 copies at the stands of the Budapest International Fair in 1991.

13. Several articles were published on our activity in different secular and ecclesiastic

papers. Among the articles published in major magazines there are two outstanding ones: the interview of András Váci entitled "Children for sale" –published in *Anna* magazine 1991/4, pages 10–12, the other is an article (entitled "The strange undertaking of a clergyman" – programme against abortion?) published in the october issue of *Családi Lap* (Family magazine) on the 11th page. Among the dailies the report published in *Kurir* on 18th january 1992 (page 6), and the whole page illustrated report of *Népszava* on 15th february 1992 (page 9, "Protection") are worth mentioning.

14. The Hungarian Television reported on us five times:

15. Our foundation was mentioned several times in the programmes of the Hungarian Radio, too, and there was an interview with the chairman of the curatorial board (e.g. *Családi Tükör* (family magazine), 4th may 1991).

According to the agreement of 30th september 1991, the Local Government of Szigetszentmiklós transferred to our foundation some buildings of its property so that we could establish a baby sanctuary. This agreement was approved by the municipal corporation in its decision No. 166/1991 at the session of 17th october 1991.

18. The Baptist Union of Hungary approved the agreement, and engaged itself in the clause of 19th november 1991 to supervise this sanctuary.

19. The State Service for Public Health issued the permission for opening the sanctuary (under the file-number 1219/1991) on 23rd december 1991.

20. On 2nd january 1992 there were two children in the Sunshine Baby Sanctuary. Our activity is patronized by well-known foreign and Hungarian personalities: senator Michael Latham member of the English Parliament, senator Tom Lantos member of the US Parliament, Rev. P. Montacute treasurer of the Baptist World League (USA), Victor E. J. Orth businessman (USA), Asztrik Várszegi abbot of Pannonhalma, Roman Catholic bishop, Loránt Hegedűs Presbyterian president bishop, János Viczián president of the Hungarian Ecumenical Consil, vice-president of the Baptist World Alliance, prof. Zoltán Papp director of the Obstetric and Gynaecological Clinics No. I., and others.




Each activity of the foundation is financed by donations, we do not receive any state funding.







I often think of you. I see as your building take shape and I take every opportunity to remind people here that we have a much easier job despite the problems over money! (I'm sorry if the English I use is difficult to understand but it will be good practice for you!)

Things with us go fairly well but at Christmas I lost my job. The company I worked for closed down my division and the whole workforce was made redundant (we all lost our jobs). I spend a lot of my time trying to find a new job but the Engineering Industry is finding it hard at the moment so there are very few jobs of any sort. We are, however, sure that God will provide the right job at the right time. If I get a job before the Summer we plan to come to Hungary as a family for a holiday. We will obviously visit Budapest to see József and Honddy and perhaps will find the opportunity to come to Szigetszentmiklós too!

Our fundraising for the Children's Home is going quite well with some gifts coming from Churches (our own included) and a number from individual Christians whom we know. I hope you have received the money we have already sent to you bank. The sum of money are not large but we are grateful and are sending all that we can at the present time so that you too can be encouraged in God's work. We are pleased also that you have received the baby clothes. A good friend of ours has taken the job of collecting and sending these off to you. We hope that these gifts will continue and that they will be of real use to you.
